

Privacy Policy

Dang Apps LLC | Last Updated: April 16, 2026

We built Dang! to help people review contracts by providing automated informational analysis before they sign them. Dang! does not provide legal advice. We aim to minimize the personal information we collect. If you submit a document, we process it to generate your analysis, report, and related outputs. We do not sell personal information. We do not use submitted contract content for advertising. We are designed to minimize retention of contract content after processing, although limited temporary retention may occur for technical, security, legal, operational, or processor-side reasons.

This Privacy Policy explains how Dang Apps LLC ("Dang," "we," "us," or "our") collects, uses, discloses, and retains information when you use the Dang! mobile application, website, web application, reports, email delivery features, and related services (collectively, the "Service").

1. Information We Collect

1.1 Information You Submit

Depending on how you use the Service, we may collect:

- contract text, document content, images, PDFs, or other files you submit for analysis;
- prompts, questions, or follow-up messages you submit when using report chat or follow-up features;
- email address if you request results, receipts, or support by email;
- support messages or other communications you send to us; and
- other information you voluntarily provide.

1.2 Payment and Transaction Information

Payments may be processed by Apple, Stripe, or another payment processor. We do not receive or store your full payment card number. We may receive limited transaction metadata such as confirmation of payment, purchase status, product purchased, amount, date, and related identifiers.

1.3 Technical and Usage Information

We and our vendors may automatically collect limited technical information needed to operate, secure, and improve the Service, such as:

- device type, OS version, browser type, and app version;
- IP address or approximate geolocation derived from IP;
- crash reports, error logs, performance data, and diagnostics;
- timestamps, request metadata, and system activity; and
- usage events needed to operate, secure, troubleshoot, or improve the Service.

1.4 Information From Third Parties

We may receive information from app stores, payment processors, hosting providers, analytics or security providers, and support tools in connection with operating the Service.

1.5 Categories of Personal Information, Purposes, and Disclosures

Depending on how you use the Service, we may collect the following categories of personal information:

- **Identifiers and contact information.** This may include your email address, transaction identifiers, device identifiers, IP address, and similar identifiers.
- **Commercial information.** This may include purchase status, transaction date, amount paid, and the product or service purchased.
- **Internet or network activity.** This may include browser type, operating system, app version, usage events, diagnostics, request metadata, and similar technical information.

- **Approximate location information.** This may include approximate geolocation inferred from IP address.
- **User-submitted content.** This may include contract text, uploaded files, prompts, follow-up questions, generated reports, report context, and support communications.

We collect and use these categories of personal information for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including to provide the Service, generate reports and follow-up responses, process transactions, deliver requested communications, support and secure the Service, prevent abuse, debug and improve performance, comply with law, and enforce our Terms.

We may disclose these categories of personal information to service providers, contractors, and vendors that help us operate the Service, such as providers of hosting, infrastructure, AI processing, payment processing, email delivery, analytics, diagnostics, customer support, and security.

We retain personal information for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, taking into account the nature of the information, the operational need, legal requirements, dispute handling, fraud prevention, and security obligations.

2. How We Use Information

We may use information for the following purposes:

- to provide, operate, and maintain the Service;
- to analyze submitted documents and generate reports, findings, and follow-up responses;
- to deliver reports or related communications by email if requested;
- to process purchases and verify transactions;
- to detect, prevent, investigate, and address fraud, abuse, security incidents, and technical issues;
- to debug, monitor, and improve performance, reliability, and product quality;
- to comply with legal obligations and enforce our Terms; and

- to communicate with you about support, transactions, or material updates.

We do not sell personal information. We do not knowingly share personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising, and we do not use submitted contract content for targeted advertising.

If our practices change in the future in a way that makes a sale, sharing, or targeted advertising opt-out right applicable under law, we will update this Privacy Policy and provide any legally required notices and opt-out methods, including any universal opt-out mechanisms we are legally required to honor.

3. How Dang! Processes Your Documents

When you submit a document for analysis, the Service may:

- receive and securely transmit the document or text you submit;
- process the content through AI-supported extraction or other parsing workflows;
- evaluate extracted information using our logic, rules, or other internal systems;
- generate a report, explanations, and related outputs;
- return those outputs to you in the app, on the web, or by email if requested; and
- retain or delete related content according to the retention practices described below.

If you use follow-up chat or report question features, we may process the report context, excerpts, findings, and your prompts to generate follow-up responses. These features are informational only and do not create legal advice.

Because contract analysis can affect significant legal or financial decisions, you should not rely on the Service alone for high-stakes matters such as eviction or lockout disputes, termination from employment, a home

purchase or sale, major business commitments, pending litigation, or other disputes that could materially affect your rights or finances.

We do not use submitted contract content to train our own general-purpose AI models. We do not use submitted contract content for advertising or cross-context behavioral advertising. Where we use third-party AI providers under commercial API terms, we seek to use providers whose commercial terms state that customer prompts and content are not used to train their general models unless the customer affirmatively opts in or separate terms provide otherwise.

4. Legal Bases for Processing (EEA/UK)

The Service is operated from the United States and is not currently directed to individuals in the European Economic Area or the United Kingdom. If we later intentionally offer the Service in those regions, we may update this Privacy Policy and related compliance measures accordingly.

5. How We Share Information

5.1 Service Providers

We use service providers to help operate the Service. Depending on the feature used, these may include providers for hosting, serverless execution, AI processing, email delivery, payments, diagnostics, support, and security. Examples may include:

- **Anthropic or similar AI providers:** to process submitted text for AI-supported extraction or response generation;
- **Supabase or similar infrastructure providers:** for hosting, infrastructure, server execution, storage, and related operational support;
- **Resend or similar email providers:** to deliver transactional emails and related metadata;
- **Apple:** for App Store distribution, payment handling, and related platform functions;
- **Stripe:** for website or web app payment processing; and

- other vendors we use for infrastructure, support, security, diagnostics, or analytics.

Where required by applicable law, we enter into data processing agreements or comparable contractual terms with service providers that process personal data on our behalf.

5.2 Legal, Compliance, and Protection Purposes

We may disclose information if we believe it is reasonably necessary to comply with applicable law, regulation, legal process, or lawful government request; enforce our Terms; protect the rights, safety, and security of Dang, our users, or others; or investigate fraud, abuse, or security issues.

5.3 Business Transfers

We may disclose or transfer information in connection with a merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, bankruptcy, sale of assets, or similar transaction.

6. Data Retention

We are designed to minimize retention where reasonably possible, but we do not promise immediate deletion in all cases. We may retain information for limited periods where needed to operate the Service, complete requested transactions, investigate abuse, satisfy legal obligations, resolve disputes, enforce our agreements, maintain security, or support backup and recovery processes.

Submitted contract content may be processed temporarily to generate analysis and related responses. In some cases, limited copies, logs, or derived records may persist for a period of time in backup systems, security systems, or service-provider environments before deletion or overwrite occurs in the ordinary course.

6.1 How we handle your documents

Uploaded contract files are deleted promptly after processing. Incomplete or abandoned uploads may persist briefly and are automatically deleted within 1 hour. Generated risk reports are retained for up to 7 days to allow

delivery and retrieval, then permanently deleted. We recommend emailing yourself a copy before closing the app.

We do not retain your original contract beyond the time needed to analyze it. Incomplete uploads are automatically removed within 1 hour. We do not use your documents to train AI models. By default, data sent through Anthropic's commercial API is not used to train AI models.

If you want your data deleted sooner, contact support@dangcontracts.com and we will remove everything we control on our systems, typically within 48 hours.

6.2 Email Addresses

If you request email delivery or contact us, we may retain your email address and related communications as needed to deliver the requested communication, provide support, maintain business records, prevent abuse, and comply with law.

6.3 Transaction Data

We may retain limited purchase and transaction metadata for accounting, auditing, tax, fraud prevention, support, and legal compliance.

6.4 Technical Logs and Diagnostics

We may retain technical logs, security logs, and diagnostics for a limited period as reasonably necessary for security, debugging, fraud prevention, product improvement, and legal compliance.

7. Data Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures designed to protect information. These may include encrypted transmission, access controls, environment restrictions, vendor management, and security monitoring. No method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

8. International Data Transfers

Your information may be processed in countries other than your country of residence, including the United States. Where required by law, we take steps intended to provide appropriate safeguards for international transfers.

9. Your Privacy Rights

Depending on where you live, you may have legal rights regarding personal information, which may include the right to:

- know whether we process your personal information and access certain information about it;
- request deletion of certain personal information;
- request correction of inaccurate personal information;
- obtain a portable copy of certain personal information;
- opt out of certain uses, including targeted advertising, sale, or profiling, where applicable;
- appeal certain decisions about privacy-rights requests, where applicable.

To submit a request, email privacy@dangcontracts.com or use any request method we make available in the Service. We may need to verify your identity before completing a request. We will not discriminate against you for exercising privacy rights granted by law.

If you are authorized to submit a request on someone else's behalf, we may require proof of your authority and information sufficient to verify the underlying user.

9.1 California and Similar U.S. State Notices

At or before the point of collection, we may provide additional just-in-time privacy disclosures when required by law. California residents and residents of other U.S. states with privacy laws can review this Privacy Policy for information about the categories of personal information we collect, the purposes for which we use them, the categories of recipients to whom we disclose them, and the rights that may be available.

10. Children's Privacy

The Service is not directed to children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. In addition, the Service is intended for users mature enough to understand and evaluate contract-related information. If you believe a child under 13 has provided personal information to us, contact privacy@dangcontracts.com so we can review and delete it where appropriate.

11. Third-Party Services and Links

The Service may integrate with or link to third-party services, sites, or products. Their privacy practices are governed by their own policies, not this Privacy Policy.

12. App Store and In-App Privacy Disclosures

If you use our iOS app, you may also see privacy-related disclosures in App Store listings, purchase flows, permissions prompts, settings screens, or other in-app notices. Those disclosures are intended to supplement this Privacy Policy.

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. If we make material changes, we may provide notice through the Service or by other appropriate means. The revised version becomes effective when posted unless we say otherwise.
